

Course Planning Chart for the English Major

*For students governed by the **new Core**, from the **Class of 2015** and after*

For charts showing what courses fulfill what area requirements, see the next pages.

1. Two courses in British/Irish literature before 1800, in two different areas.

This field is divided into three areas: Medieval; Renaissance; and Restoration and 18th Century. To fulfill the requirement, you take two courses in different areas.

2. Two courses in literature primarily after 1800.

One course must be in **British/Irish literature** and the other in **American literature**. One must be in **19th century literature** and one must be in **literature after 1900**.

To fulfill this requirement, you will end up taking one of these two pairs of courses:

(2A) a course in British/Irish literature after 1900 with one in American literature to 1900

or (2B) a course in American literature after 1900 with one in 19th century British/Irish literature.

(Don't rely on the CAPP program to tell you whether you have fulfilled this area requirement; it does not assess this requirement properly.)

Note your flexibility here: if you happen to take courses in both areas of American literature, you can fill in the other part of the requirement with **either** British/Irish area; similarly, if you take courses in both areas of British/Irish literature, you can fill in the other part of the requirement with **either** American area.

3. The Junior Research Seminar, numbered 2250, taken in the junior year or earlier.

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4. A Senior Seminar.

This course, numbered 5000, is a capstone course for your experience as an English major. At least two seminars, limited to English majors and capped at 15 students each, are offered each term.

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5. Five electives.

These courses can be any English department courses numbered 2000 and above, with the partial exception of the British Literary Tradition and American Literary Tradition courses (2101, 2102, 2103, 2104); a student may count only two of those courses towards the major.
