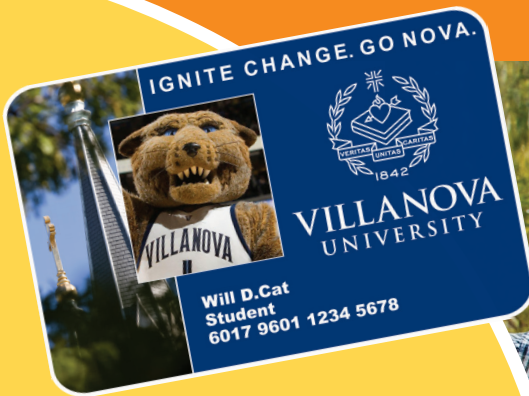


Everything You Need To Know About The

# WILDCARD



The official identification card for Villanova University that gives you access to:

**NovaBucks, Residential Halls, Restricted Areas Around Campus, Dining Services, Vending, Library Privileges, Printing, Off-Campus Merchants, Student Organization Events or Activities, and University Bookstore.**

Why use **NOVA BUCKS**?

**Nova Bucks** is accessible through the student's Wildcard, making it a convenient and secure payment method. If a card is lost or stolen, the student can put an immediate hold on activity. **Nova Bucks** can not be overdrawn, no minimum balance is required, and students can grant guest access to run reports to view account activity. Funds will transfer from year to year, and any balance greater than \$10 is refunded upon leaving Villanova.

## V MOBILE

V Mobile allows you to manage your **Nova Bucks** account online! You can make a deposit, check balances, suspend your account, view transactions and have an email sent to you or your parents letting you know when your balance is low. To load the V Mobile App, go to [wildcardonline.villanova.edu](http://wildcardonline.villanova.edu) from your Smartphone and log in using your Villanova username and password.



## NOVA BUCKS ACCOUNT

This restricted spending account allows you to use your Wildcard to make purchases throughout the campus and in the surrounding community without carrying cash, credit cards or checks.

## Making A Deposit

Adding money to your Wildcard's **Nova Bucks** account is easy, fast and convenient. To get started, you can make a deposit by mail using a check or in person using cash, check, credit card or Apple Pay at the Wildcard office and at the **Nova Bucks** revalue machines located in Dougherty Hall. No service fee applies. You can also visit [villanova.edu/wildcard](http://villanova.edu/wildcard) and select "Add **Nova Bucks** Here." Deposits online can be made using a major credit card—a \$2.50 processing fee will apply to all online deposits.

Please note: Once you put the money into your account, the balance stays with you until you graduate or terminate all affiliation with Villanova University. There are no cash withdrawals.



## WILDCARD MOBILE

Access your residence hall or grab a snack at selected vending machines by using your mobile phone:

- Connect to VUMOBILE WIFI Network
- Download the CBORD Mobile ID for CSGold from the App or Play Store
- Open the App and click “Settings”
  - Click the drop down and select “Villanova”
  - Click authenticate my device
  - Enter your Villanova username and password
  - Click authorize and you’re all set!



## UNIVERSITY BOOK STORE

Students receive a **5% discount** on all purchases and online ordering when paying with **Nova Bucks**.
