**A MERIT TUITION RATE FOR STUDENTS EARNING AN ASSOCIATES DEGREE AT ONE OF OUR COMMUNITY COLLEGE PARTNER SCHOOLS. **20% discount** for those students graduating with a 3.0-3.49 G.P.A. **25% discount** for those students graduating with a 3.5-4.0 G.P.A. for each course taken at Villanova.**

**Students will be eligible for consideration if they have:**

- Completed or will complete an Associate degree at one of the following schools:
  - Bucks County Community College
  - Delaware County Community College
  - Harcum College
  - Harrisburg Area Community College
  - Lehigh Carbon Community College
  - Montgomery County Community College
  - Reading Area Community College
  - Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology.
- Graduates with an Associate degree will be granted admission under the terms of the Transfer Agreement with the understanding they may need to complete some additional courses based on curriculum.
- Completed all required admissions paperwork for a bachelor's degree through Villanova University's College of Professional Studies;
- Been accepted as matriculated students into a bachelor's degree program through Villanova University's College of Professional Studies;
- Established a final cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or higher upon completion of Associates degree at one of our community college partner schools
- Submitted a Community College Discount Request Form

**Requirements for continuation of the merit tuition rate are as follows:**

- Minimum enrollment of six credits per semester is required while at Villanova University;
- Students who qualify for the merit tuition rate must remain in good academic standing while attending Villanova University.
- Do not attend another institution of higher-education between the time you graduate and enroll at Villanova University in a bachelor's degree program.
