A clinic also satisfies the practical writing requirement. <b>Concurrent enrollment prohibited:</b> No student may take more than one experiential class (clinic or externship) in a single semester. **Prerequisites:**

Students must check the course descriptions for every course before registering to determine if the course carries a pre- or co-requisite.
