VILLANOVA BAND

The Villanova Band is one of the most dynamic and visible performing ensembles on campus. Each academic year, the VU Band proudly presents more than 75 performances, ranging from signature concerts to spirited appearances at home football games, Men's and Women's basketball games—including postseason play—and many of Villanova's most cherished campus traditions.

You'll find the VU Band energizing occasions such as 1842 Day, Special Olympics, New Student Orientation, the Espiritus Nova Campaign, and Pops in the Pavilion. VILLANOVA CHORALE, VILLANOVA SINGERS, AND VILLANOVA VOICES

The Villanova Chorale (a mixed choir of students, faculty, staff, and community members), Villanova Singers (traditional men's choir), and Villanova Voices (treble choir) together represent the vibrant choral tradition of Villanova University.
