1. Where does the money go?

- Office of Disability Services Student Grant: Funds that would be allotted to this grant would allow students in the office of disability services to apply for grant money to help with books, supplies, and technology to help offset the cost that comes with a full time student living on campus with a disability.
- Next LEVEL Inclusion/Social Activities: Funds that would be allotted to this area would allow LEVEL to plan and execute off campus social activities such as our Annual Retreat, day trips, and any other social activity that would promote team building and social awareness. The funds here would help keep the per activity cost down for each student involved in LEVEL and will also help with the cost of transportation and housing for our students with specific disability accommodations.
