## **Housing Assignments**

We know finding out your housing assignment is a top priority, and we are working hard to place each student. First-year housing assignments and roommate information will be available the week of July 21. Students will receive a notification via their villanova.edu email address when housing assignments are available. Your housing assignment will also include a link to a 3D model of your room that will allow you to take accurate measurements and configure furniture layouts. We appreciate your patience as we house the Class of 2029!

#### **Move-In Arrival Times**

Shortly after receiving housing assignments in July, students will be able to sign up for an arrival time on Move-In Day, Wednesday, Aug. 20. Students who are unable to arrive on Wednesday may move-in on the morning of Thursday, Aug. 21. (Please note: The New Student Orientation Program will have optional programming in the morning on Thursday; Orientation will officially begin at 1 p.m.) More details regarding move-in will follow later this summer.

### What to Bring/What Not to Bring

Ahead of move-in day, please familiarize yourself with our list of suggested items to bring to campus. It is equally important to read about what not to bring to campus, as well as about securing insurance for your personal belongings. Please visit the Office for Residence Life's Incoming Students website to learn more. (Please note: U-Hauls and other rental trucks will not fit in Villanova's parking garages. In the next few weeks, we will share information regarding how you can ship packages to campus prior to Move-In Day to allow you to bring items in a passenger vehicle.)

## **Mattresses**

All first-year student residence halls are equipped with extra-long mattresses measuring 36"x80"x7". These mattresses require extra-long twin-sized sheets.

## Microfridge

Residential students living in non-apartment/suite units can have a microwave and dorm-size refrigerator (3.0 cu. ft.) in their rooms. Students can choose to purchase their own unit or rent from Microfridge. Students who order a Microfridge by Friday, July 25 will have the unit delivered to their rooms before moving in.

## Move-In Day Pop-Up Shop

On Move-In Day, the University Shop will host a Pop-Up Shop tent in the center of campus. Stop by to browse their selection of room accessories, bedding, shower and bath supplies, extension cords, storage bins and desk accessories, and stock up on Villanova gear for your crew!
