Students in the College of Professional Studies are adults balancing the pursuit of their education with a wide variety of life's commitments. Nearly all CPS students have full-time jobs—and many are raising families, saving for their own children's college tuition, or taking care of aging parents, all of which can impact their own finances. Many CPS students are able to take only one course at a time, which can make earning a degree, or even a professional certificate, a very long endeavor.

Increased endowed scholarship funds to support tuition would make a tremendous difference in the lives of our students and also make the College more accessible to a greater number of students.

Endowed funds can also be established to support students' professional development opportunities including participation in internships, study abroad and immersion programs, as well as to provide emergency "rainy day" funding to cover student needs, like transportation or childcare.

Academic Innovation



As a college focused on students already in the workforce, it is imperative for CPS to develop innovative and responsive academic offerings. CPS seeks to create new programs and courses focused on translating theory into practice, developing specific skills needed across industries, and providing engaging educational experiences for our students.

Seed funding is critical to the successful launch of new programs or initiatives, providing resources to find outstanding faculty and to develop successful permanent programs for the College of Professional Studies. For example, generous gifts launched Villanova Interdisciplinary Immigration Studies Training for Advocates (VIISTA), VUnited Scholars, and our Annual Leadership Symposium.

With expanded funding, CPS can continue to adapt to changing trends, market its programs to audiences across all industries, and provide students with the kind of training that can be directly translated from the classroom to their careers. CPS is also developing new Centers of Excellence to cultivate innovative opportunities and welcomes support.

VUnited Scholars



The College of Professional Studies is home to the VUnited Scholars program, a residential academic certificate program for students with mild to moderate intellectual disabilities. Students in the VUnited Scholars program further their education in the classroom, gain experience through internship opportunities, and develop personally and socially.

This program presents unique, often unanticipated challenges that require significant financial support. Substantial gifts or an endowed directorship would allow this program to continue to grow and develop, by hiring more staff, offering scholarship opportunities, and creating dedicated space for the program.

Bernard John Lucci Senior Citizen Personal Enrichment Program

The Bernard John Lucci Senior Citizen Personal Enrichment Program allows individuals aged 65 and over to continue furthering their education, as part of Villanova's mission to create a community of lifelong learners. Through the program, students can enroll in select undergraduate courses. CPS takes pride in supporting individuals seeking lifelong learning and our undergraduates greatly benefit from the life experience and wisdom that our senior citizens bring to the classroom. An endowed directorship would enable CPS to grow this popular program even further.

Pre-College Summer Academy

Villanova's Pre-College Summer Academy offers high school students the opportunity to study at a collegiate level, explore the student experience, and develop the skills to succeed in higher education. Support for this program would include scholarships to fund this experience for students otherwise unable to consider an investment in their future.
