As we gear up for the start of the fall semester, I want to share some important updates and reminders with you.

Textbook Access Program (non Law, EMBA, Grad Tax, or study abroad)

Students in credit-bearing undergraduate and graduate programs, except as noted above, are part of the textbook access program which provides students all of their required course materials for a fixed fee of \$20 per credit in which they are enrolled. You may opt out of this program here (by 9/3) and purchase materials on your own. Digital materials in the program will be delivered in Blackboard. Print materials in the program must be selected for pick up (in Garey Hall room 10A) or delivery here prior to receiving them. If you are only in courses that start after 9/3 you may opt out by emailing coursematerials@villanova.edu. All questions can be addressed to coursematerials@villanova.edu.

Artificial Intelligence

When it comes to your academic experience at Villanova, your professors determine if and when generative AI can be used for graded assignments in their courses. If you are unsure about their expectations, ask for clarification and review the Villanova Code of Academic Integrity or for the Law School the Academic Code of Conduct. These codes specifically prohibit using AI generators to fulfill essential requirements of an assignment—such as reading, synthesizing, interpreting, writing, coding, or programming—without both explicit instructor permission and proper attribution and citation of any AI-assisted components. Students who violate the codes are subject to disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion. Inappropriate use of AI for course work undermines the purpose of your education and will have negative consequences for your long-term career success.
