In Memoriam: Thomas Hanratty, PhD, '47 ChE

Villanova Engineering alumnus Dr. Thomas Hanratty died on August 24, 2016 in Urbana, IL. A leading researcher in the field of fluid mechanics, he was elected to the National Academy of Engineering, the National Science Foundation and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. The American Institute of Chemical Engineers named him one of the most influential chemical engineers of the post-World War II era.
