- **Upgraded Self Service HelpDesk (SSHD)** is now available for the Villanova Community. Please go to support.villanova.edu and log in. Feedback on the new portal is appreciated.
- **Blackboard Assignments - A New Look!**

Faculty and students returning for the Spr18 semester will find several enhancements have been made to the Assignments tool in Blackboard. Support for over a hundred new file types has been added to the presentation of assignments in addition to the ability to manage multimedia assignments. Faculty can add annotations to the assignments via a web browser or the Bb Grader app for instructors. Previously created rubrics for scoring assignments remain available. Updated drag and drop capability makes submitting an assignment much easier, click-and-hold to drag your file from you desktop or documents folder and drop into Blackboard!

- **Files Restore in OneDrive**

OneDrive for Business Files Restore is a new Office 365 feature. If any OneDrive files get deleted, corrupted, or infected by malware, with the File Restore feature, you may be able to restore your deleted files. Files Restore helps you undo all the actions that occurred on both files and folders within the last 30 days.

- **Enhanced Security feature for Office 365**

Office 365 Advanced Threat Protection has been expanded to protect more of your online files. In addition to sending messages with Exchange Online, people regularly share files and collaborate using SharePoint Online, OneDrive for Business, and Microsoft Teams.
