- **Villanova Community Author Event: Joseph Orazi '72 CLAS on his Book *L'America* on 10/21**

Please join us on Monday, October 21 at 12:30 p.m. in Falvey Memorial Library's room 205 for a talk by Joseph Orazi '72 CLAS on his book *L'America*. Orazi will discuss the late 19th and early 20th century emigration of Italians to this country, including the reason for the exodus of millions and the brutal passage via steamship during those years. He will cover the challenges of assimilation, concluding with the largely unknown events (the labelling of Italians as enemy aliens, internment in camps throughout the country, and forced relocation on the west coast) leading up to World War II. This event, co-sponsored by Falvey Memorial Library and Ciao Philadelphia, is free and open to the public. Light refreshments will be served.

**Alfred F. Mannella and Rose T. Lauria-Mannella Endowed Distinguished Speaker Series featuring Massimo Faggioli, PhD on 11/5**

Please join us on Tuesday, Nov. 5, at 1 p.m., in Falvey Memorial Library's room 205 for the annual Alfred F. Mannella and Rose T. Lauria-Mannella Endowed Distinguished Speaker Series lecture, featuring Massimo Faggioli, PhD, Professor of Historical Theology, Department of Theology and Religious Studies at

Villanova University. Dr. Faggioli will present a talk titled, "The Shifting Meanings of 'Roman' in US Catholicism during the Last Century." He will discuss how American Catholicism has changed enormously during the last one hundred years. Part of this change has to do with the shifting perceptions of the role of Rome and the Vatican for Catholicism and for American Catholics in particular: religiously, symbolically, theologically, organizationally, and politically. The lecture will identify some different macro periods in the history of the relations between (Italian) American Catholics and the Vatican, with some insights on the present period during pope Francis.
