



HIRAIR AND ANNA HOVNANIAN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Hirair and Anna Hovnanian Foundation established the Hirair and Anna Hovnanian Scholarship in 1990 in order to provide financial opportunities to academically talented students of Armenian descent to attend Villanova University. The scholarship covers partial tuition and is renewable each year. The award is offered to qualified students whose families currently reside in the United States, are US citizens/permanent residents, who have exemplary high school records, correspondingly high SAT or ACT scores, and are of Armenian descent. Demonstrated financial need may also be taken into consideration.

In addition to this application, candidates must also complete the Common Application with the Member School Section for Villanova by January 15 of their senior year, as well as a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the College Board CSS Profile Form by January 15 of their senior year. The Selection Committee will review qualified applicants and will notify the recipients by the end of June. Returning undergraduates will be considered for scholarship renewal based on academic performance, financial need and good standing as per Villanova's Code of Conduct.
