Explanation of Each Sub-Committee / Role:

Service Sites - **led by Mary Kate and Kate:** Responsible for oversight of the Service Site Captains and the partnerships with the sites, helping to coordinate on-campus and off-campus service. This committee will work closely with all other committees to determine and support site needs.
