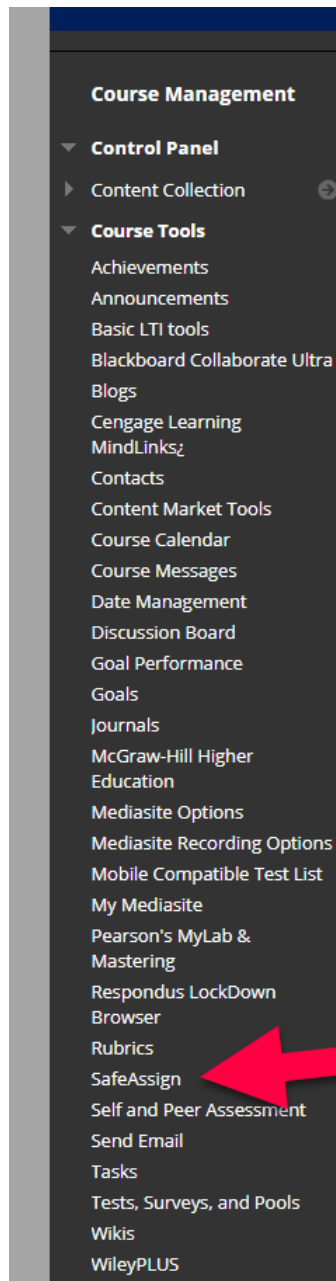

Summary

Public administration is defined as the organization and management of people and materials to a different areas of public administration in the United States, which include ethics of public service, interorganizational relations, leadership, human resources, budgeting, financial management, and some of the fundamental ideas and issues associated with each area.
